### TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

**FROM BRATTLEBORO, VT (41 miles)**  
Take Route 9E to first Hillsboro exit. At the end of the ramp take a right, and then at the lights (McDonalds) take a left onto Route 149(West Main St). Go through the lights at Shaws and at the next set of lights turn right(Staying on Rt. 149). Oxbow Campground is approximately ¼ mile on the left.

**FROM SALEM, NH (62 miles)**  
Take I-93N to Concord, NH then I-89N to exit 5 (left hand exit). Go about 14 miles on 202&9 to the first Hillsboro exit. Go left at the end of the ramp, then approximately ¾ miles to the traffic light in the center of town. Turn left at the light (Rt. 149) and Oxbow Campground is approximately ¾ mile on the left.

**FROM PORTSMOUTH, NH (75 miles)**  
Take Route 4W to Concord. Take I-393W to I-93S, to I-89N to exit 5 (left hand exit), then follow the directions from Salem

## Recycling

Oxbow Recycles! At check in you will be given one plastic recycling container for soda cans, beer cans, etc. We also supply all our short-term campers with clear garbage bags. Have all trash at the edge of your site at 1:00 pm and we will pick it up and dispose of it for you. Large items incur handling & disposal charges. If you have any questions about recycling please see one of Oxbow's friendly staff members.



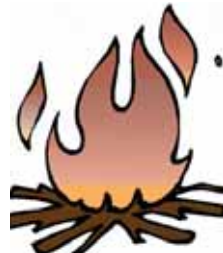
## Restrooms

Oxbow staff takes great care in providing clean, well-equipped restrooms. We need and expect your help in keeping them that way. Please escort young children to restrooms.



## Parking

Please park only one vehicle at each site. We have provided several extra parking areas within the campground that are an easy walk to most campsites. Please see a staff member for an appropriate parking permit for these areas.



## Fire Safety

Use only campground fireplaces or rings where you find them. Only wood or paper in the fireplace and all combustible material must fit inside the fireplace. Flames should always be knee high or lower. Completely extinguish all fires before leaving or retiring for the evening.



## Car & Bicycle Safety

The maximum speed for any vehicle, even bicycles, is 5 mph at all times. All bicycle riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet. Expect children to do the unexpected and please drive cautiously.



## Pets

There are six (6) basic understandings for pets.

1. You must show proof of rabies shot.
2. Pets must be leashed while outside.
3. Keep pet picked up after.
4. Please keep them quiet.
5. NEVER leave them alone.
6. No dogs allowed on beach or in swimming pond.



## Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are in effect from 10 pm to 8 am, everyday including weekends. Both fires and noise must die down at 10:00 pm. Please respect your neighbors right to a peaceful environment.



## Visitors/Guests

The registered camper is always responsible for the safety and actions of their guests or visitors. Please make sure they understand and follow Oxbow's policies. All visitors must register at the office upon arrival. The camper must inform their guests of the campground rules and be responsible for both their own and their visitors observance of the rules.



## Beach & Pond Safety

Swimming and boating are strictly at the participants' risk and there is no campground supervision of the pond areas. Please help keep the beach area clean and NO PETS at the beach or in the swimming pond. Anyone under 18 MUST wear a life preserver while using flotation devices, such as canoes, pedal boats, etc.



## Alcoholic Beverages

To foster moderation, Oxbow has a "one beverage" understanding. Please have no more than one beverage per person open at any time. The Welcome Hall is kept as a substance free building. No alcohol or tobacco is allowed inside.

## Child Safety

Parents are expected to supervise and protect their children at all times. Parents are responsible for their children's actions while in the campground.

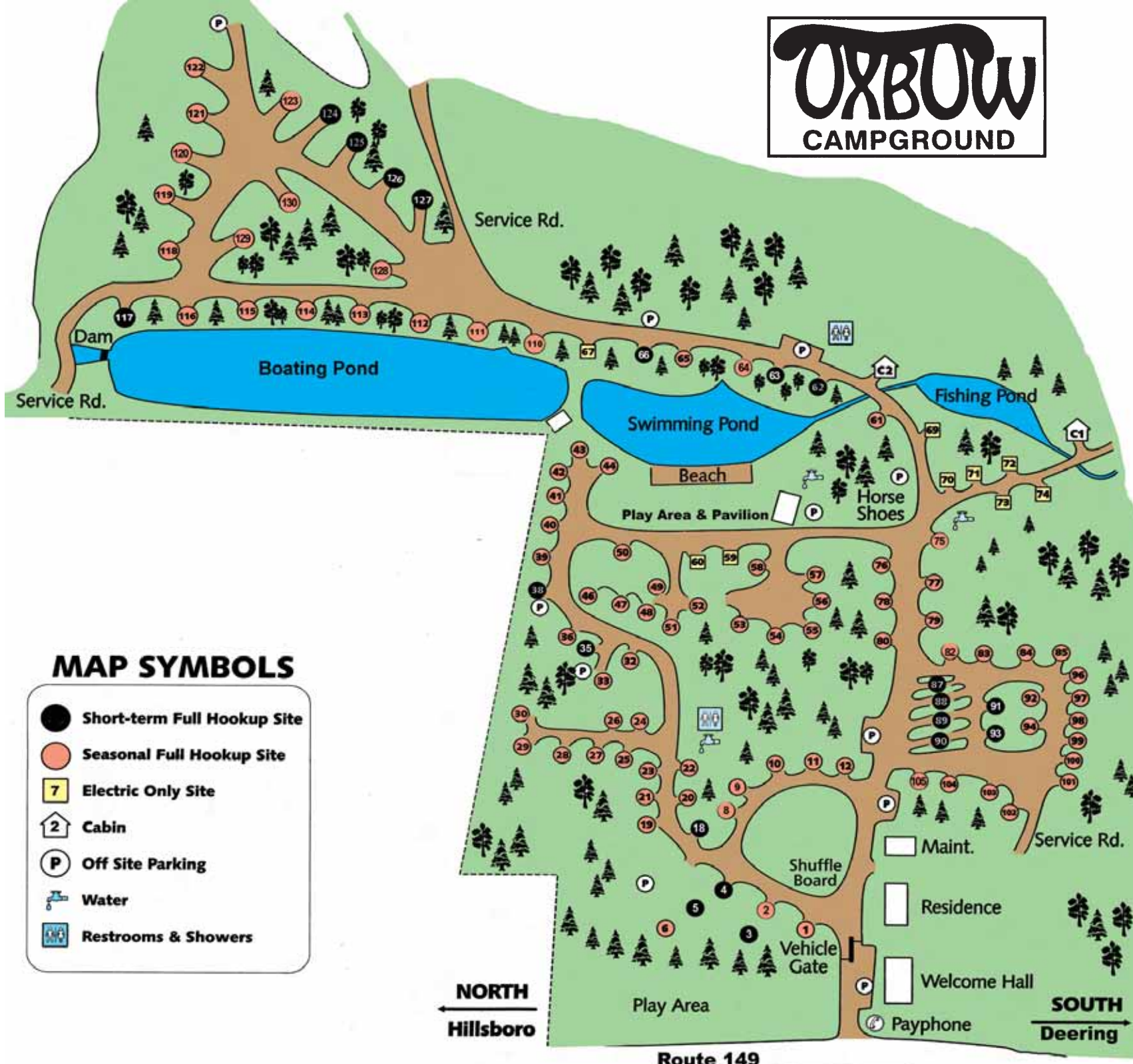
